
The increase in the importance of entrepreneurship makes a great contribution to the country's economies in terms of economic and social development. Increasingly, entrepreneurial activities activate stagnant economies and contribute to the creation of new business areas and the solution of employment problems. In addition, entrepreneurship increases the acceleration of technological development. Entrepreneurship is also seen as an important tool for the growth of developing economies.

With the development of the term business and economics, certain principles have emerged for entrepreneurial activities. Entrepreneurship principles give us information about what entrepreneurship actually is. There are 10 principles. Information on these principles is as follows:

1. Developing a Solution: It is an illusion that entrepreneurship makes quick money. It should not be forgotten that entrepreneurship is actually solving problems and contributing to society or a field.

2. Having a Vision: Entrepreneurship means having a good vision. In other words, you, as an entrepreneur, take action to add different and needed value to the world.

3. Build a Perfect Team: Entrepreneurship is a long and difficult journey. But the most effective way to make it easier: Building a great team. Working with people who will take ownership of your business as much as you do and who can make a big impact, who will move your initiative forward.

8. Value on Customers: Customers are important for your business and products. It is very important to care and listen to your customers' needs.



10.Being patient: Entrepreneurship can be a difficult challenge. But making your dreams come true is in your hands. You must never give up and be patient !






Types of Entrepreneurship

- 5. Rural Entrepreneurship





Eco-entrepreneurship can be defined as environmentally conscious entrepreneurship. The important thing in eco-entrepreneurship is that the entrepreneurs are environmentally friendly. This type of entrepreneurship, which came to the fore with the increasing importance of environmentalist movements, sought solutions to environmental problems that the world and people needed, but also led to the emergence of new business ideas.



Digital Entrepreneurship has emerged with the advancement of technology. It includes entrepreneurial activities carried out in order to adapt technology-based applications and ideas to real life. In this type of entrepreneurship, there are software, programming and application types that both businesses and people's needs.









How to Become an Entrepreneur?




Having a Stable Financial Structure We mentioned earlier that entrepreneurship is not a quick way to make money. Finding a financial source or nurturing the company financially is important, but the success of a startup depends on how hard you think and work on your business ideas. Instead of making quick money or worrying about money, you should create a stable finance structure by making a solid budget plan and creating smart resources, and spending most of your remaining time working and generating ideas.



Acquiring New Skills

Entrepreneurship has a close relationship with self-development and learning. It will be a great advantage for you to specialize in a subject and to have knowledge on different subjects related to or completely different from this subject. For example, you studied business administration and you are an expert in this subject, but having a basic knowledge of technology will help you generate ideas about the information systems that you may need for your business or to understand the subject faster. Therefore, you must constantly learn, experience and research. You can learn about them from different learning websites, academic articles and workshops and seminars that you can attend in. Also, your personal development is just as important. Because being a healthy individual and developing routines can help you to focus more on daily life.







Taking advantage of different channels

As we mentioned in the previous title, learning is very important for entrepreneurship. The best way to learn is to learn the same subject from different channels and not be tied to just one idea or one channel. For example, just reading a book or books with the same content gives you limited information. Learning the same topic from different channels with different perspectives - podcasts, webinars, magazines, panels, etc. - can improve your perspective. Therefore, it is extremely important how and through which channels you learn a subject and how much you diversify the content of the subject.
