Youthpass certificate will not be given to the participants who do not fully participate.

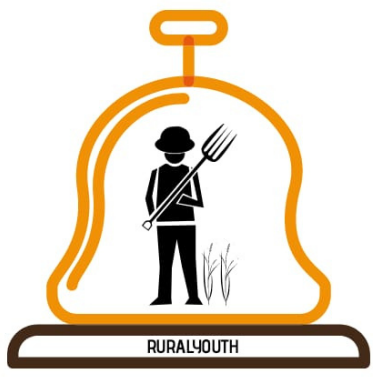
Contestants who will make a presentation in the Idea Contest must submit their presentations to the person in charge of the registration desk with their group and team names on 14 December 2022.

## Accommodation

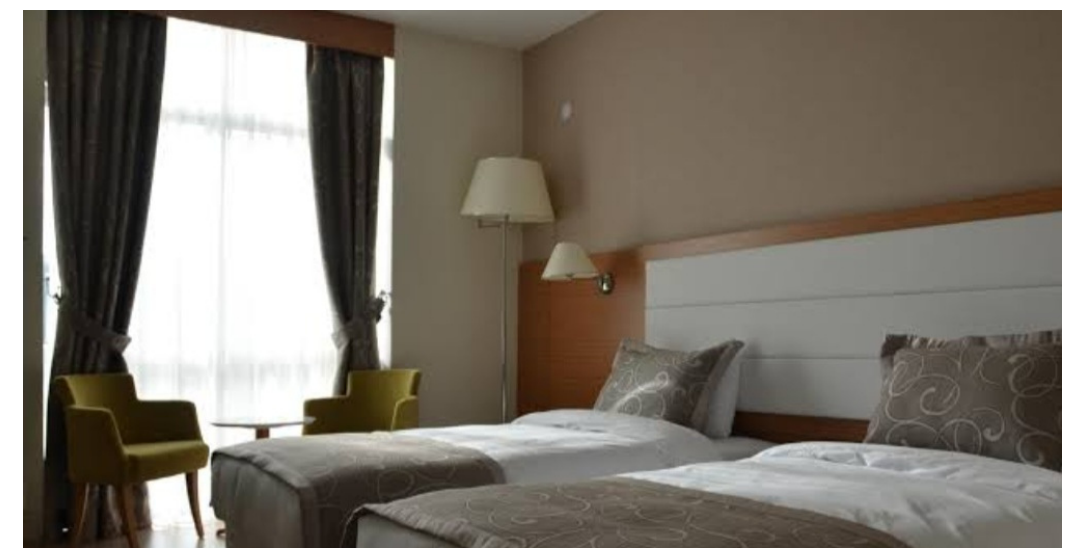
Participants will stay in ESOĞÜ Hotel. Accommodation will be in single and double rooms.

Lunch will be served in the hotel restaurant and is free of charge.

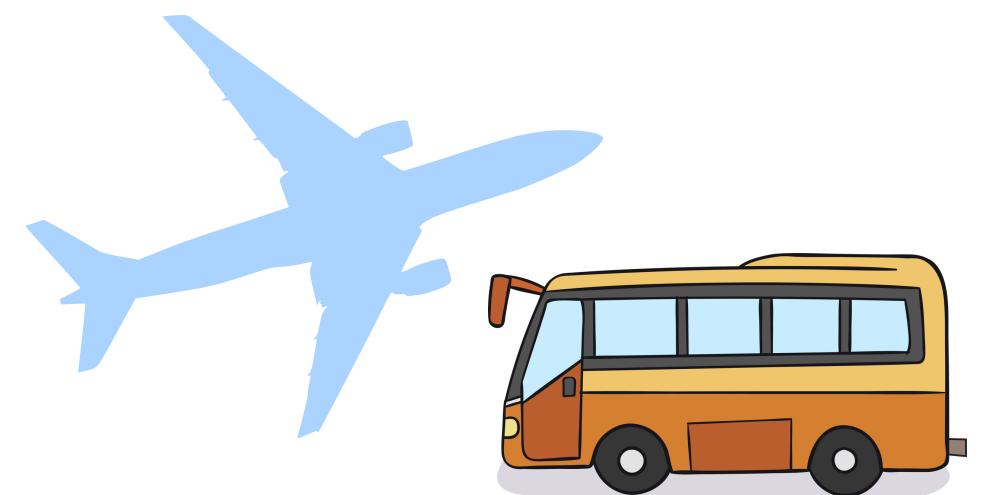
Dinners belong to the participants (Self Arrangements). There is no budget for dinners.

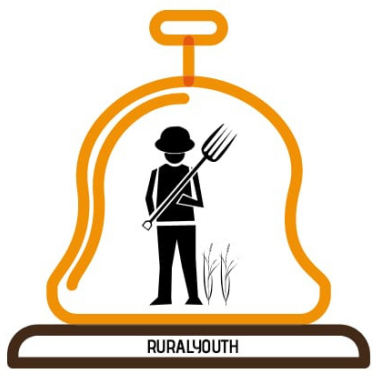

15 December 2022

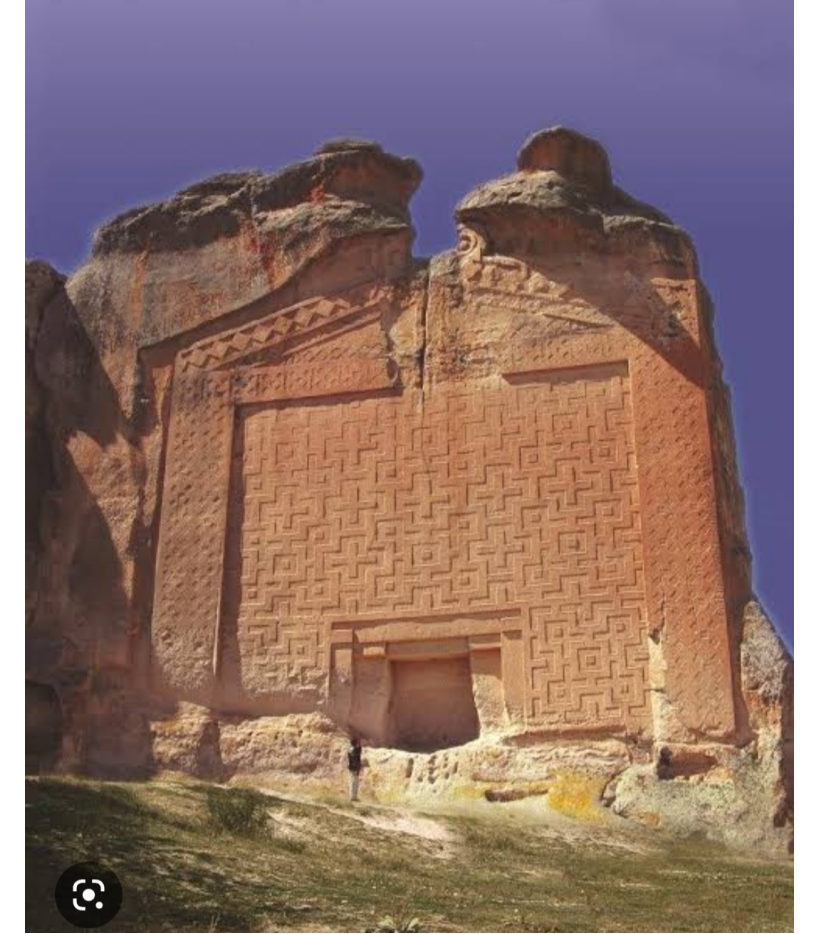
On the second day of the event, after lunch, Han district of Eskişehir province and the Phrygian valley will be visited. The fieldtrip bus will depart from Esogü hotel entrance gate at 14.00. The trip is free.

Han District

Han which was established at the intersection of historical trade and caravan routes (King Road - Hajj, Caravan and Sefer Road (Baghdad Road)), has hosted many civilizations. It is an exemplary district with its historical areas and tourism applications.

Phrygian Valley

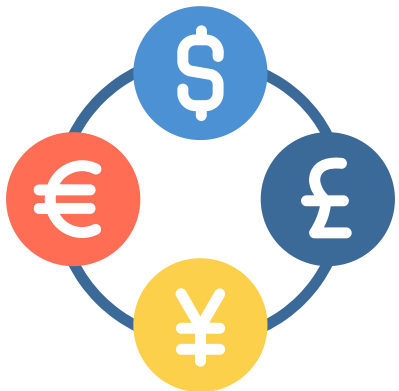
The Phrygian valley, located within the borders of Eskişehir province, is a tourist attraction center. Phrygian plateaus covered by the tuffs of the Turkmen Mountain; B.C. It was inhabited by the Phrygians between 900-600 BC. The fact that the volcanic tuff is an easily workable rock enabled the Phrygians to use them for various purposes by carving and chipping. From that period, open-air temples, altars and rock tombs dedicated to the mother goddess Kybele, and many structures for defense and shelter have survived to the present day.



Eskişehir is famous for its Çibörek, halva and boza foods. There are traditional food restaurants in many parts of the city.

There are also modern restaurants and bars.

Average food prices in the city vary between 50 and 120 TL. There are also cheaper or more expensive restaurants.
